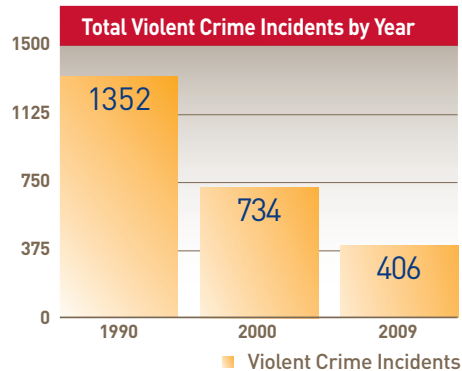


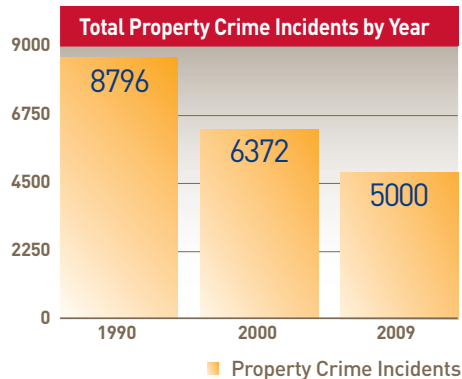

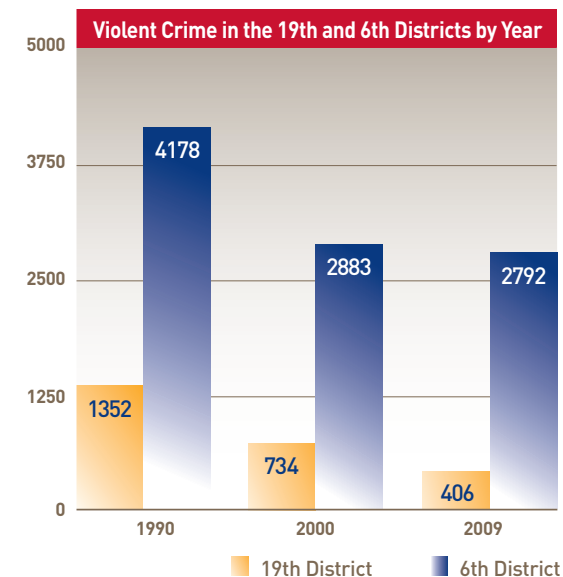
### Top Five Most Frequent Calls for Police Service

Calls for service detail a combination of the types of events that citizens in the district have called for police service and the types of reports most commonly written by police.

- The calls for service also show across the board reductions – the most frequent event type for police service in the 19th district saw a 15% reduction from 2008 to 2010.
- The most commonly cited event type changed from disturbances in 2008 to traffic stops in 2009 and 2010.
- Over the course of three years there was a 28% reductions in disturbance related calls for police service.



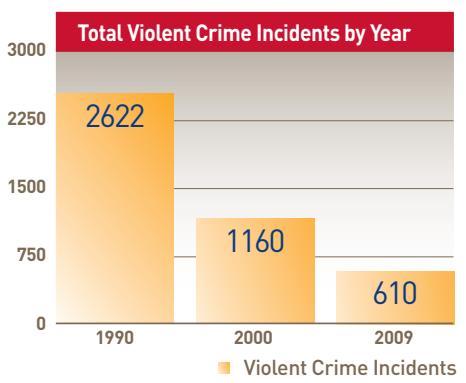
### 2009 Per Population Calculations

19th District - Violent crimes per person:	0.003
19th District - Property crimes per person:	0.050
6th District - Violent crimes per person:	0.040
6th District - Property crimes per person:	0.060

- Violent crime dropped 70% from 1990 to 2009, which included a 45% drop in violent crime from 2000 to 2009.
- Property crime dropped 44% from 1990 to 2009, which included a 22% drop in property crime from 2000 to 2009.
- From 2000-2009 the 19th district recorded the 4th lowest total in the total number of violent crimes committed.

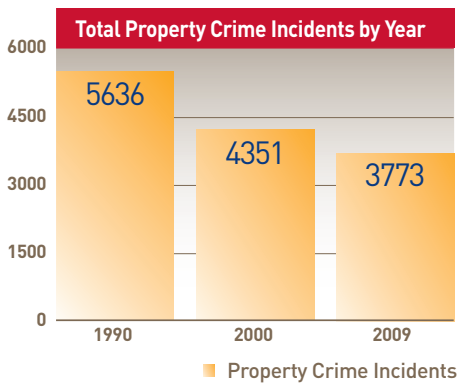

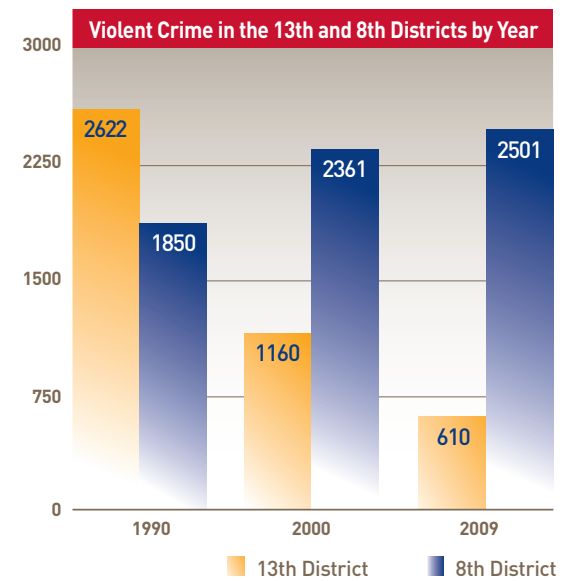

- The most commonly cited event type changed from PRE in 2008 to disturbances in 2009 and 2010.



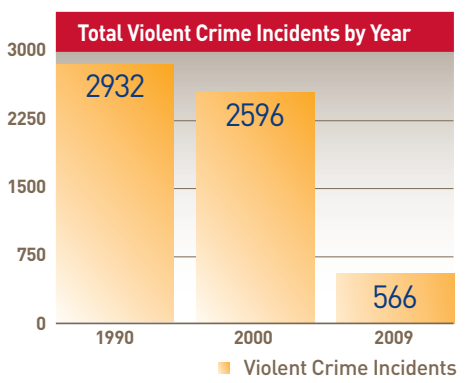
### 2009 Per Population Calculations

13th District - Violent crimes per person:	0.01
13th District - Property crimes per person:	0.06
8th District - Violent crimes per person:	0.01
8th District - Property crimes per person:	0.04

- Violent crime dropped 77% from 1990 to 2009, which included a 47% drop in violent crime from 2000 to 2009.
- Property crime dropped 33% from 1990 to 2009, which included a 13% drop in property crime from 2000 to 2009.

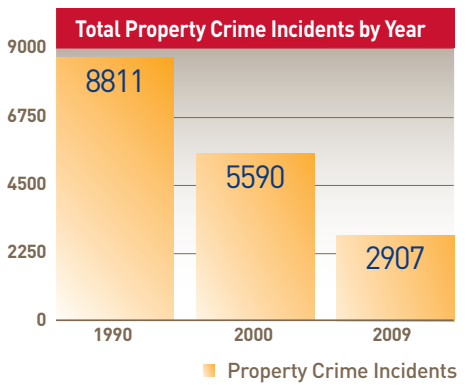

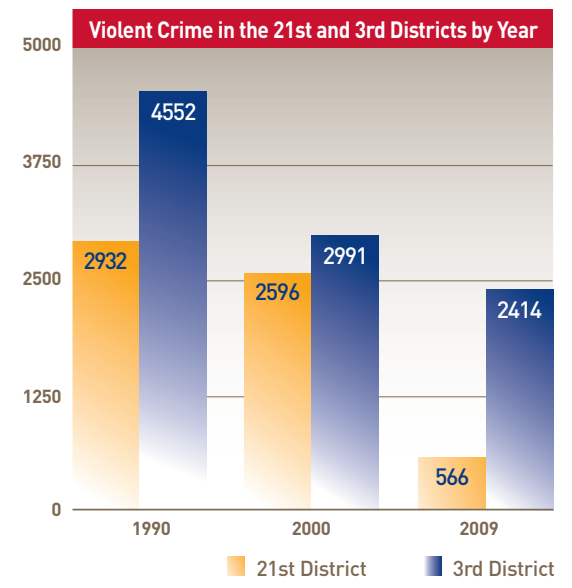

Calls for service detail a combination of the types of events that citizens in the district have called for police service and the types of reports most commonly written by police.

- Violent crime dropped 81% from 1990 to 2009, which included a 78% drop in violent crime from 2000 to 2009.
- Property crime dropped 67% from 1990 to 2009, which included a 48% drop in property crime from 2000 to 2009.



### 2009 Per Population Calculations

21st District - Violent crimes per person:	0.007
21st District - Property crimes per person:	0.037
3rd District - Violent crimes per person:	0.037
3rd District - Property crimes per person:	0.056

- The calls for service also show across the board reductions – the most frequent event type for police service in the 21st district saw a 67% reduction from 2008 to 2010.
- The most commonly cited event type changed from PRE in 2008 to traffic stops in 2009 and 2010.
