ORDER

This matter coming on to be heard on the petition of the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, by PATRICK J. FITZGERALD, United States Attorney for the Northern District of Illinois, for an Order instructing MICHAEL MCDERMOTT to testify at trial in the above-captioned case, said MICHAEL MCDERMOTT has stated that if he were a witness at trial, he would assert his privilege against self-incrimination, and the Court having considered said petition of the United States Attorney and the letter approving the application to this Court from the Assistant Attorney General of the Civil Rights Division, United States Department of Justice, attached to said petition:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that MICHAEL MCDERMOTT shall not be excused from testifying at trial in the above-captioned case on the ground that the testimony or evidence required of him may tend to incriminate him, and that MICHAEL MCDERMOTT shall proceed to the place of trial and answer the questions which he is asked without further asserting there his privilege against self-incrimination.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that no testimony of the witness, MICHAEL MCDERMOTT, compelled under this Order (or any information directly or indirectly derived from such testimony, documents or other information) may be used against him in any criminal case,

except a prosecution for perjury, giving a false statement or otherwise failing to comply with this Order, in accordance with the provisions of Section 6002, Title 18, United States Code.
